

- **LOS Program (Legacy Open Space):**
The county program through which the house and grounds at Warner Circle, formerly known as Circle Manor, have been preserved in perpetuity, in recognition of the site's high preservation value as the heart of the town's historic garden suburb plan. The central oval known to many as "The Circle" was originally home to Brainard Warner, the founder of Kensington, incorporated in 1894.

Maryland:

- **MHT (Maryland Historical Trust):** The state agency dedicated to preserving and interpreting the legacy of Maryland's past. Through research, conservation and education, MHT assists the people of Maryland in understanding their historical and cultural heritage. MHT administers the state tax credit program, which offers a credit of 20% for qualified rehabilitation expenditures, both interior and exterior, on historic buildings. Approval must be granted **prior** to performing any work on the structure(s).
