- Aug 23 [Spencer J](#): Sophisticated, syncopated, mystifying folk
- Aug 30 [Dede & the Do-Rights](#): Fusion of vintage country music and vocal harmonies with an early rock 'n roll feel. Beautiful harmonies and the band's infectious energy make you want to dance the night away
